With Sivia as our guide, we are welcomed into the design process – creativity, trial and error, fresh perspectives, motivation and flow.

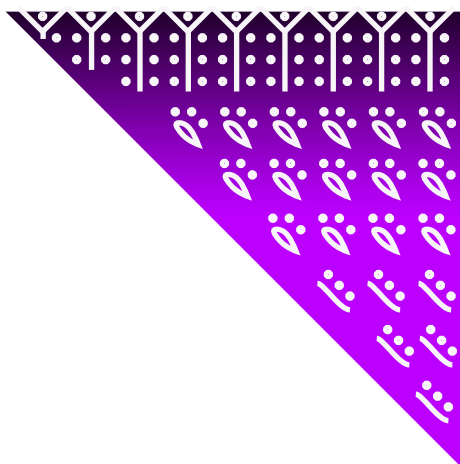
Sivia is generous and encouraging, helping knitters to access their creativity and express their visions through stitches, patterns, and ultimately a unique triangular lace scarf or shawl.
